Last chance to see *Colours of Impressionism* with 'Fridays in July'

For the final weeks of *Colours of Impressionism: Masterpieces from the Musée d'Orsay*, the Art Gallery of South Australia is hosting a month of late-night events across every Friday in July.

With more than 65 Impressionist masterpieces on display from the renowned collection of the Musée d'Orsay in Paris, *Colours of Impressionism: Masterpieces from the Musée d'Orsay* charts the revolution of colour that lies at the very heart of Impressionism. For the final month of the exhibition, visitors to the Art Gallery's 'Fridays in July' will experience a year of seasons through Summer, Autumn, Winter and Spring. Each Friday night, Gallery goers can view *Colours of Impressionism*, as well as enjoy a host of programs inspired by the Impressionists and the changing colours of the seasons. This will be the last chance to visit the exhibition after-hours, before the masterpieces depart North Terrace and return to the Left Bank on July 29. Full program includes:

A Night of Summer Colour Friday 6 July, 5-9pm

Join jeweller Lauren Simeoni in her Frou Frou Pour Toi wearable art workshop, take part in a wine-tasting masterclass, sketch from the masterpieces with Luke Thurgate's drawing workshop or be transported to Paris with some of Adelaide's finest jazz musicians.

A Night of Autumn Colour Friday 13 July, 5-9pm

Participate in a Passion and Pastels drawing workshop with artist Roe Gartelmann, hear from special guest Terence Maloon, Director, ANU Drill Hall Gallery & University Art Collection, who is presenting a talk on 'Pissarro and the theory of Impressionism', enjoy a compelling live performance by Naomi Keyte and join us for talks and tours.

A Night of Winter Colour Friday 20 July, 5-9pm

Experience the technique of oil painting in a workshop with Archibald finalist Tsering Hannaford, soak up the sounds of Nancy Bates as she performs with pure emotion, then listen to floor talks and tours.

A Night of Spring Colour Friday 27 July, 5-9pm

Enjoy *Mélange à Trois*' sultry blend of French classics and original music, take part in a spring-inspired floristry workshop and join us for talks and tours.
