

Photography in the Gallery Policy

Photography in Non-Restricted Areas

Visitors are permitted to take photographs, for personal use, in all areas of the gallery unless signage advises that photography is restricted in a specific area.

Permission to take photographs in non-restricted areas of the Art Gallery of South Australia is granted on the understanding that the Gallery does not authorise any photography or use of photographic material that may infringe the copyright or moral rights of the artist. Photographs may only be taken with hand-held cameras. The use of tripods, flash or additional lighting is not permitted. Filming and video-recording are also not permitted.

Photography in Restricted Areas

In restricted areas such as temporary exhibitions, signage at the entrance will advise of any photographic restrictions. Applications for photography in restricted areas, filming or use of additional equipment must be made in writing to the Publications Officer: Image Sales & Rights. Fees and conditions may apply.

Requests by media organisations for photographic material, or access to the Gallery, for photography or filming should be directed to the Gallery's Communications Manager.

Wedding Photography

Wedding photography is not permitted inside the Art Gallery of South Australia however may be taken on the gallery forecourt. No special permission is required to take wedding photography on the Gallery forecourt however respect must be shown to Gallery patrons, public sculptures and infrastructure when doing so.

Permission to take wedding photography inside the Art Gallery of South Australia is only granted if the wedding party are holding their ceremony at the Gallery. Photography is only valid on the day of the ceremony. Requests for access to the Gallery for weddings should be directed to Art Gallery Food + Wine.
